



CT WITH CONTRAST PREPS:

- If you are having IV contrast please follow food and drink instructions prior to exam.
 - In addition, if you are having IV contrast, you must bring a list of their current medications including the dosage
 - Please note, if taking Glucophage, Glucovance, or Metformin and getting IV contrast do not take the drug the morning of and for 48 hours after test.
- If you are having oral contrast (abdomen, pelvis or combination), please pick up the prep no later than 9:00 PM the night before the test OR please arrive 3 hours and 30 minutes prior to you appointment (for appointments scheduled for 10:00 AM and later)
 - Please bring written physician order when you pick up your prep
 - All patients need to take the oral prep even if the order states without contrast
- You must drink oral prep 3 hours prior to appointment start time. Additional instructions will be given to you when you pick up your prep.
 - However please remember no food or drink other than water 4-hours prior to exam but drinking water prior to the exam is encouraged to stay hydrated
- If your test requires blood work, please complete this prior to the exam.
- If you had films done of the area previously at a different facility please bring them with you to this appointment
- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your appointment and go to the main lobby desk (information)
 - If appointment is after 7:00 PM during the week or 2:00 PM on Saturday/all day Sunday, please go to ER Registration.
- Please note, your insurance card and photo ID will be copied and co-payment/deductible collected upon arrival.
- Consult your physician on medication restrictions for this test, or if you have any questions feel free to call 630.856.7070.
- Please do not bring any unattended children to this appointment.
