Excellence in Patient Care

Advanced Cardiac Services

Adventist Cardiovascular Network provides cardiovascular services including high-tech diagnostic, surgical and rehabilitation programs for patients with heart disease. Services include Level II Trauma for emergency heart, open-heart surgery, cardiac catheterization and electrophysiology studies and device implants. There are also a full range of non-invasive cardiac testing procedures — including the 64-slice CT scanner, which in many cases eliminates the need for an (invasive) angiogram, as well as cardiac rehabilitation, community education, health screening and wellness programs. Acute inpatient care is available in the intensive and intermediate care units.

The Birth Center

Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital offers an all-encompassing Family Maternity Program dedicated to nurturing, informing, and ensuring the most comfortable and memorable experience for both mother and newborn in newly renovated, private rooms. Services include Labor Delivery Recovery Birthing Rooms, Family Suites for extra privacy, childbirth education classes and more.

Cancer Care

The cancer program of Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital is approved by the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons as a comprehensive community cancer program. This designation recognizes excellence in numerous aspects of cancer diagnosis, treatment, education and rehabilitation services. The program offers the multi-specialty collaborative capability of a major medical center, while providing a warm and personal treatment environment.

The care provided is delivered by specially-trained and dedicated physicians, nurses, pharmacists, social workers, pastoral care, therapists, and dietitians. We offer more than 30 cancer-related clinical research trials in La Grange and more than 90 clinical research trials to our community through the Adventist Cancer Network, providing access to investigational drugs and new treatment. Each year we care for hundreds of community members who are newly

diagnosed with cancer, as well as thousands of survivors, who are living with a cancer diagnosis. A free-standing Cancer Treatment Pavilion on the hospital campus provides outpatient chemotherapy and radiation therapy treatments.

Emergency Services

Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital's Emergency Department provides acute, emergent services to patients of all ages. The Emergency Department physicians are board certified in Emergency Medicine. The Emergency Department is a designated Level II Trauma center with varied specialties on-call. A helipad on the roof of the Emergency Department ensures rapid helicopter transfer availability. Registered Nurses in the Emergency Department are Trauma certified and hold certifications in Pediatric and Adult Cardiac Life Support. Emergency Department Approval for Pediatrics (EDAP) status for Emergency Medical Services Region 8 in Illinois has been renewed.

Rehabilitation Services

Adventist Paulson Rehab Network provides excellent rehabilitation services for individuals who are recovering from serious illness or injury. Experienced, licensed professionals provide Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language Pathology services. Rehabilitation programs are goal-oriented and individualized to meet the specific needs of the patient. The goal is to partner with our patients to help them reach their highest functional potential. Inpatients on medical/surgical floors receive treatment at the hospital. Outpatients receive therapy at Adventist Paulson Rehab Network La Grange Center.

Attention to Aging Adults

Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital offers a spectrum of services to meet the diverse needs of aging adults. Trained experts, including physicians certified in geriatrics, address changing physical, psychological, spiritual and social issues. In addition to general acute care, an Alzheimer's Assessment Program, and specialized outpatient services are offered through Adventist Midwest Geriatrics Specialists. The ConfiCare Act II program offers seminars, activities, and health screenings especially for mature adults.

Radiology Services

Our radiology department offers state-of-the-art technology to perform a variety of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures. These tests provide your doctor with a complete assessment of your condition so that appropriate treatment can begin immediately. Each of our technologists is registered and licensed; they work closely with the board certified radiologists to provide the utmost quality care.
