## Jake's Story

In May 2004 when we delivered our second son, Jake, at Adventist Hinsdale Hospital, our baby was rushed to the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), a place that was extremely scary to us...at first. During the weeks that followed we spent our days and nights in the NICU rocking chairs, holding our son or rocking next to him while he slept in his bed. We both vividly remember wanting to be able to get the really nice yellow cushioned rocking chair while visiting with our son.

We remember the day we were sitting in the yellow chair holding Jake, when the doctors told us they figured out what was wrong with Jake and that his condition was "not compatible with life." We sat there rocking in the yellow chair that night processing the fact that Jake wasn't going to make it.

Fortunately, we were able to take him home after one month in the NICU and had him at home with us for two months. Our son Jake died in September 2004.

Our family wanted to honor our son in some way and decided that the best way would be to help provide enough comfortable rocking chairs for all the NICU parents. Rockers like the special yellow chair we remember so well, where they can rock their tiny infant and just be a family for a few minutes in the midst of all of the activity around them. And so, seven years later, the Keep Rockin' Project was born to help support parents during a stressful time and help them be as comfortable as possible.
